
We are so glad you have decided to join us this year as we look into the book of Nehemiah. We hope you enjoy your study.




What do I do when I'm finished?

2 - Strong's Concordance

This one can be a bit tricky to use so be sure to follow these steps & ask for help!

1)Look up the word in the main concordance (the front section) just like you would in a regular dictionary.

2)Use the location of the word in the Bible to link it up to the Strong's number in the main concordance.

3)Use the number to look up the reference in the Hebrew dictionary which is found behind the main concordance.

4)You can also search for where the words are found by looking up the word in the main concordance and looking at all the different occurrences.

1 - Your Bible

We used the King James to write the workbook, so most of the answers will come from there. We also recommend having the ASV or RSV to help understand what you are reading (you can find these online, but make sure you have your parents permission first!).



The 36th chapter of 2 Chronicles shows the punishment on Judah due to the wicked actions of the people. In this punishment, the capital city of Jerusalem is destroyed, the walls of the city are broken down, and many of the people of Judah are taken into captivity. Nehemiah was one of the first of his brethren to be taken by the Babylonians and was later sent to the city of Shushan in Persia. After he became the kings cup-bearer, we see that he is given the opportunity to travel back to Jerusalem to rebuild the wall and the temple. In the book of Nehemiah, we see the struggles that he faces while trying to rebuild Jerusalem. We can learn many things by looking at the example of Nehemiah while he continued to

work for his people in Jerusalem.

Nehemiah chapter 11 is a list of names that was produced for those who were in Jerusalem. This list can be called a "census" or a "register". There are a few reasons for putting together this list. The first was to ensure that if they were attacked or there was a natural disaster, the leaders of the people would know who was living in the city. Another reason was for taxing purposes. A third reason was so that future generations would know that their ancestors had a part in the rebuilding of the wall and in living in Jerusalem. This list continues into the first section of Nehemiah 12 where it specifically lists the Priests and Levites that were among the people to first go up into the city of Jerusalem.



WHEN THE WALL WAS COMPLETED, THE PEOPLE WANTED TO HAVE A DEDICATION CEREMONY TO THANK GOD FOR HIS HELP AND TO DEDICATE THEMSELVES TO CONTINUALLY SERVING HIM. THIS CEREMONY INCLUDED SACRIFICES TO GOD AND, WHILE IT WAS GOING ON, ALL OF THE PEOPLE AND THEIR FAMILIES REJOICED.
