The cities of the land of Canaan, including Ai, were full of sinful people. This means that the King of Ai can be used to represent the king of sin. Under the law, anyone who committed a sin worthy of death was to be hung on a tree and taken down at night. This points forward to Christ, who, although sinless, was crucified in order to kill sin.
