



2 - Strong's Concordance

This one can be a bit tricky to use so be sure to follow these steps & ask for help!

- 1)Look up the word in the main concordance (the front section) just like you would in a regular dictionary.
- 2) Use the location of the word in the Bible to link it up to the Strong's number in the main concordance.
- 3) Use the number to look up the reference in the Hebrew or Greek dictionary which is found behind the main concordance.
- 4) You can also search for where the words are found by looking up the word in the main concordance and looking at all the different occurrences.

1 - Your Bible

We used the King James to write the workbook, so most of the answers will come from there. We also recommend having the ASV or RSV to help understand what you are reading (you can find these online, but make sure you have your parents permission first!).

3 - Bible Dictionary

Use this just like a regular dictionary or encyclopedia. All you have to do is look up the subject - everything is listed in alphabetical order!



THE PARABLES ARE LOCATED IN THE GOSPELS OF MATTHEW. MARK & LUKE. IN MATTHEW 13:13-16 WE READ THAT CHRIST SPOKE IN PARABLES BECAUSE "THEY SEEING, SEE NOT; AND HEARING, THEY HEAR NOT, NEITHER DO THEY **UNDERSTAND ... FOR THIS PEOPLE'S HEART IS WAXED GROSS, AND THEIR** EARS ARE DULL OF HEARING, AND THEIR **EYES THEY HAVE CLOSED ... BUT BLESSED** ARE YOUR EYES, FOR THEY SEE: AND YOUR EARS, FOR THEY HEAR." IN OTHER WORDS, BECAUSE MOST PEOPLE THAT JESUS CHRIST SPOKE TO WERE HARD-HEARTED, HE SPOKE IN PARABLES, SO THAT IT WOULD ALLOW HIM AND HIS DISCIPLES TO SEE WHO WAS TRULY PAYING ATTENTION TO HIS WORDS.


Ghe fellowservant responds the same way the servant did when the king requested payment in verses 25 & 26 yet the king's servant does not follow the example set by the king.

People often talk about God's grace and mercy and although they might seem to be the same thing, they are very different. Grace is undeserved kindness (something that God is giving us that we do not deserve). Mercy is when God withholds our punishment (when he forgives us for something we have done because we ask for forgiveness and repent even though we should be punished for our actions).

Tomentor: often referred to a jailer

The parable of the unforgiving servant reminds us that we must forgive others. The amount of sins that we are forgiven for, because we ask for our Heavenly Father's grace and mercy, is like \$14 million, compared to \$2 worth of sins that others have committed against us. We need to make sure that we immediately forgive others. When we do, after we plead with our God, we also can be forgiven.

THE TORMENTOR FOR US IS FAILING TO RECEIVE OUR HEAVENLY FATHER'S FORGIVENESS. WHEN THIS HAPPENS, WE ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL OF OUR SINS. WE ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR FORGIVING OTHERS. IF WE DO NOT FORGIVE OTHERS THEIR SINS, THEN WE ARE GUARANTEED THAT WE WILL NOT BE IN THE KINGDOM.
